You will need to complete your theory assessment, your workplace supervisor will confirm that you have undertaken the tasks as part of your work and then your assessor will observe you at work to confirm your competence. Sometimes you will need to be observed over a number of visits.

The Certificate II in Automotive Body Repair Technology qualification is made up of 13 units. The maximum duration of this traineeship is 12 months for full time employees and 24 months part time, depending on knowledge and experience.
